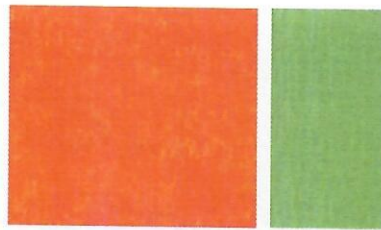

All moneys due to Council will be payable on the first day of the month following the month of consumption and /or usage, failing which, interest may be levied after the due date.
